The BCDTS training philosophy is to primarily use positive reinforcement and reward to shape behaviour, while recognising that purely positive training will not work for all dogs in all situations. We acknowledge that all dogs and owners are different and that the approach to training must be tailored to individual needs.

We cater for behavioural problems and provide support for owners of more challenging dogs.

We provide flexibility in our training so that members can progress at a rate that fits their capabilities, commitments and family situation. Each of our grades develops core skills, but progress is tailored to the individual and dog. Fun, games and an introduction to agility and fly-ball are included.
